- 18-21-2-5-14-19 was a Flemish artist whose works are largely religious, such as *Descent from the Cross*. **RUBENS**
- The term 19-5-3-21-12-1-18 refers to worldly, rather than religious, concerns. **SECULAR**
- The Dutch artist 18-5-13-2-18-1-14-4-20 was known for his use of color in paintings such as *The Anatomy Lecture*. **REMBRANDT**
- Renaissance composer 16-1-12-5-19-20-18-9-14-1 is known for his church music.

- Gargantua* was written by 18-1-2-5-12-1-9-19. **RABELAIS**
- 3-1-13-15-5-14-19 wrote about Portuguese history in *The Lusiad*. **CAMOENS**
