Early History

- Semitic people
- Migrated to Syria during the decline of the Hittites (circa 1100 B.C.E.)
- Established small, prosperous kingdoms

Damascus

- Leading Aramean kingdom
- Circa 1000-700 B.C.E. traded heavily
- 732 B.C.E. conquered by Assyria

Contribution: Language

- Aramean alphabet adopted by new Babylonian empire (7th century B.C.E.)
- Common language of the Near East
- Temporarily replaced Hebrew
 - Used for some later books of the Christian Old Testament/Hebrew Tanakh
 - Spoken in Greco-Roman Palestine and Judea – spoken by Jesus
