


The French Empire • Iog4-Iog2 - Fought for independence • March, 1062 - coase-fre • July, 1962 - independent • French Guinea • Iog6 - voted for its independence and joined the U.N. • Togoland and Cameroon • Franch Hedl trustesships from League of Nations (after WWI) and United Nations (after WWI) • Independent in 1960 • Did not join the French Community • Joined the United Nations • Malagasy and Mali • Joined the soon-defunct French Community
