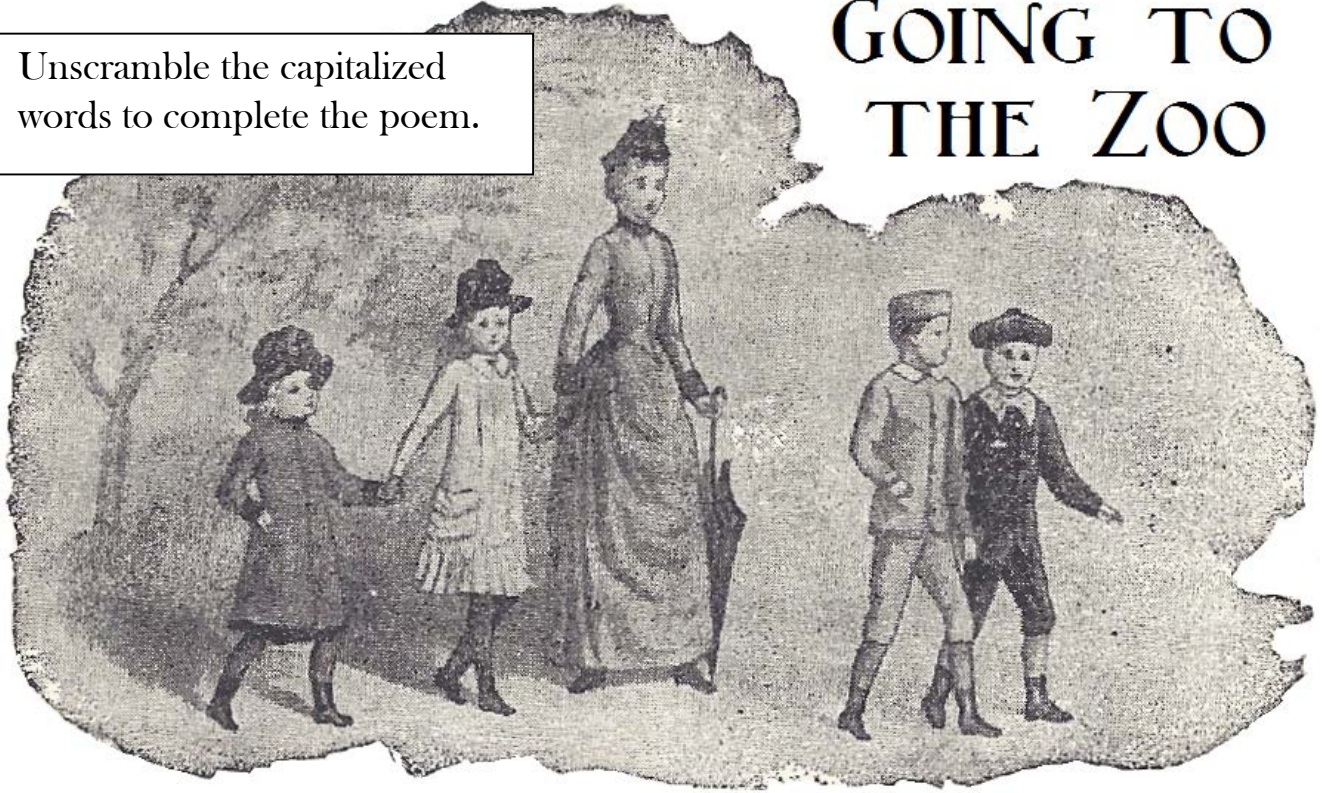


Unscramble the capitalized words to complete the poem.
